## Notice to Skippers No. 38/2021

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (Dz. U. /Journal Of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568, 1901, 2170, and of 2020, item 284), the Regional Water Management Board in Gliwice informs that after the passage of the flood wave, starting from 6:00 a.m. on 10 August 2021, the Oder Waterway between km 174+850 (Hydrological Facility in Zawada) and 181+300 (the border of the RZGW (RWMB) in Gliwice) will be opened for navigation, with the fairway depth of 120 cm.

Due to incomplete marking of the navigation route, we ask all captains of the vessels to exercise extreme caution during navigation.
