Notice to Skippers No. 41/2021

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (Dz. U. /Journal Of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568, 1901, 2170, and of 2020, item 284), the Regional Water Management Board in Gliwice would like to announce that from 13 August 2021, from 6:00 a.m., the minimum waterway depth on the following section of the Oder Waterway will change from 120 to 140 cm: 98+600 km (OH Januszkowice) to 181+300 km (mouth of the Nysa Kłodzka River – the boundary of the Gliwice RWMB).
