



Notice to Skippers No. 50/2021

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (Dz. U. /Journal Of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568, 1901, 2170, and of 2020, item 284), the Regional Water Management Board in Gliwice informs that after the passage of the flood wave, starting from 14:00 a.m. on 8 September 2021, the Oder Waterway between km 150+500 (Hydrological Facility in Opole) and 181+300 (the border of the RZGW (RWMB) in Gliwice) will be opened for navigation, with the minimum fairway depth of 120 cm.

The section between km 51+000 (City of Racibórz) and 150+500 (Hydrological Facility in Opole) of the Oder River remains closed.
