

Notice to Skippers no. 5/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1, point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2021, item 2233, as amended) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on Inland Navigation (Dz. U. /Journal Of Laws/ of 2020, item 1863, as amended) the Regional Water Management Board in Gliwice would like to announce that **from 11 May 2022 from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm the Kędzierzynski Canal will be closed for navigation and the water level will be lowered by 60 cm on the 2nd section of the Gliwice Canal (Nowa Wieś lock (km 7+800) - Sławięcice lock (km 15+110)). The fairway of the second section of the Gliwice Canal at the aforementioned date will be 120 cm.**

Lowering of water level is caused by the necessity of carrying out repair works of upper gates at the Nowa Wieś lock, at km 7+800 of the Gliwice Canal.
