



Notice to Skippers No. 7/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1 point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2021, item 2233, as amended) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on Inland Navigation (Dz. U. /Journal Of Laws/ of 2020, item 1863, as amended) the Regional Water Management Board in Gliwice hereby informs that on 23 May 2022 from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm the water level will be lowered by 60 cm on the 3rd section of the Gliwice Canal (Sławięcice lock (km 15+110) - Rudziniec lock (km 21+570)). The minimum waterway depth of the 3rd section of the Gliwice Canal at the above date will be 120 cm.

Lowering of the water level is caused by the necessity of carrying out repair works on the upper gates of the northern chamber of the Sławięcice lock, at km 15+110 of the Gliwice Canal.
