

### Notice to Skippers no. 6/2023

Pursuant to Article 14 1(4) of the Act of July 20, 2017 – Water Law (Journal of Laws of 2021, item 2233 as amended) and Art. 43 section 6 of the Act of December 21, 2000 on inland navigation (Journal of Laws 2020, item 1863, as amended) The Regional Water Management Board in Gliwice informs that **from March 23, 2023 from 06:00 a.m. the Gliwice Canal at km 0+000 - 39+400 and the Kędzierzyn Canal at km 0+000 - 5+600 will be open for shipping.**

Open shipping lane with restrictions:

1. The Gliwice Canal:

- Transit depth - 180 cm.
- Due to the siltation of sections no. V (Dzierżno - Łabędy) and no. VI (Łabędy – Gliwice Harbour), the transit depths are maintained in the canal axis, while at the banks the depths are between 100 and 180 cm.
- Local shallowing at the entrance to the Kędzierzyn Canal - depths range from 120 to 170 cm.

2. The Kędzierzyn Canal:

- Transit depth - 120 cm.
- Due to local outwashes and unregulated banks, we recommend taking extra caution when cruising and sailing in the axis of the canal.

**The locks on the Gliwice Canal from March 23, to April 08, 2023 will be open from Monday to Saturday from 06:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. However, from April 09, 2023 the locks will be open 7 days a week from 06:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.**
